1. Information:

- AHA / SCAHPERD Recruited 634 schools to host a JRFH/HFH event
- 452 schools completed a JRFH/HFH event
- SHAPE America received \$42,143.00 from SC of JRFH/HFH events from the AHA.
- SCAHPERD received \$21,071.54 from SHAPE America for their portion of the collected revenues.
- South Carolina JRFH/HFH events had an increase of donations for the state of 1.6%
- New process to complete free memberships for coordinators that raised \$2000 or over from SHAPE America and SCAHPERD
- All reports required by SHAPE America from JRFH/HFH were completed on time.
