**Proposed Motions to the SCAHPERD Membership**

Myrtle Beach, SC

November 12, 2017

The following motions for amendments to the SCAHPERD By-Laws have been made for consideration at the Annual SCAHPERD Business Meeting in Myrtle Beach on November 12, 2017. All SCAHPERD Professional, Honorary Life, and Retired Professional members and the Affiliate member designee shall have voting privileges. All members shall be allowed speaking privileges at the annual meeting. Please review the following proposals in preparation for discussion and voting.

In addition and according to the SCAHPERD By-Laws, Article IX—Procedures for Amending; Section 2. “When the proposal is not initiated by the Constitution Committee a minimum of seven (7) SCAHPERD members must sign a request for amending the Constitution or By-Laws.”, if anyone has amendments to propose, they must obtain the required signatures and submit it to the membership three weeks prior to the annual meeting.

Additions to SCAHPERD By-Laws highlighted in yellow

Rationale for additions in blue

1. Accept the following addition to the **SCAHPERD By-Laws, Article VI-SCAHPERD Structures, Section 3c**: Each Association shall:

c. establish and administer programs to serve its membership: **“such programs shall be scheduled no closer to the SCAHPERD annual conference than eight (8) consecutive weeks prior to or eight (8) consecutive weeks following the conference. All association programs dates shall be approved by the SCAHPERD Board of Directors.”**

Motion made by: Board of Directors

Rationale: Having dates approved by the SCAHPERD BOD assures that programs will not conflict so that individuals from all associations could attend any program. It is difficult or impossible for the SCAHPERD office to handle the paperwork and details for more than one program at a time.

2. Approve the following membership dues increases begin January 1, 2018, and adjust the **SCAHPERD By-Laws, Article VIII—Dues and Finances, Section 2. Annual Dues:**

- a. The annual dues shall be ~~thirty five (35)~~ fifty (50) dollars for Professional, ~~twelve (12) eighteen (18)~~ dollars for ~~Students~~ Future Professionals, forty (40) dollars for Affiliate, ~~fifteen (15)~~ twenty (20) dollars for Retired Professional, and twenty (20) dollars for Guest Membership, such dues shall constitute membership for one calendar year from the date of payment.
- b. Professional members may purchase a two-year membership for ~~sixty (60)~~ ninety (90) dollars. Two-year memberships may be purchased on the professional member's next renewal date.
- c. Such dues shall be due and payable annually at the time of the annual conference or at the date of application for membership. Distinctive membership cards shall be issued only upon payment of dues.

Motion made by: Board of Directors

Rationale: SCAHPERD will be providing \$1,000,000 general liability policy as a member service to professional and future professional members and the dues increase reflects that service cost.  
Dues haven't been raised in more than 10 years.

The editorial change from the word "Students" to "Future Professionals" is being made to match the membership designation of "Future Professionals" in the SCAHPERD Constitution.

3. Approve an additional professional membership option for a three-year membership. The cost for a three-year membership would be \$125.00. This will necessitate a change in the **SCAHPERD By-Laws, Article VIII—Dues and Finances, Section 2. Annual Dues:** by adding letter c. to Section 2. and relettering of c. to d. (see previous motion for exact placement in By-Laws.

- c. Professional members may purchase a three-year membership for one hundred and twenty-five (125) dollars. Three-year memberships may be purchased on the professional member's next renewal date.
- d. Such dues shall be due and payable annually at the time of the annual conference or at the date of application for membership. Distinctive membership cards shall be issued only upon payment of dues.

Motion made by: Board of Directors

Rational: This would offer an additional savings over the two-year membership for professional members.  
The last sentence is added to match what is in the By-Laws concerning the two-year membership.
